

Curriculum Information Autumn 2 Year 6





Our topic this half term is 'World War 2'.

World War 2 was a deeply significant event in British and world history. We will learn about the causes of the war, Churchill and Hitler, the Blitz and the Battle of Britain. We journey into the life of children at the time, using our book the 'Wolf Hollow'.

As writers, we will be writing stories, flashbacks and non-chronological reports.

As readers, we will read Lauren Wolk's Wolf Hollow and learn about Annabelle's life during WW2.

In Maths, we will learn about calculation problems; fractions, decimals and percentages; and missing angles and lengths.

In Science, we will learn about electricity.

In Computing, we will consider online safety, specifically focussing on our own online reputation and the impact of online bullying. We will also design and create text adventures using coding software.

In Design and Technology, we will work with textiles to design and create a personal mobile phone case.

In History, we will learn about the impact of World War 2 on children and the wider European community.

In Languages, we will be speaking, listening and writing about our homes.

In Music, we will compose and sing a syncopated melody, perform a class arrangement and analyse historical recordings of big band swing.

In PE, we will take part in dance and tag rugby.

In PSHE, we will be learning about different relationships, including safe and unsafe friendships and interactions:

In RE, we will learn about Christianity and Christians' beliefs about death.

In Art, we will be looking at Henry Moore and creating wartime scenes using charcoal and chalk
