WB: 02.03.2026	-tial <i>After a consonant letter (but there are exceptions)</i>	partial, essential, torrential, confidential, sequential, impartial, influential, initial, martial, potential
WB: 09.03.2026	Silent Letters Silent t	thistle, mortgage, hustle, jostle, bristle, bustle, castle, fasten, nestle, glisten
WB: 16.03.2026	ie for 'ee' <i>When making the 'ee' sound, i comes before e except after c (but there are exceptions)</i>	achieve, brief, field, shield, chief, piece, relief, shriek, retrieve, priest
WB: 23.03.2026	Revision week - the class teacher will choose words and spelling rules to focus upon based on previous misconceptions or errors within independent writing.
