




Curriculum Information

Spring 1 Year 6



Our topic this half term is 'Frozen Kingdoms'.

The early twentieth century was a time of innovation and exploration. From the ambition and tragedy of the Titanic, we will learn about what changed in law to make ships safer following this and how historical evidence can be interpreted in different ways. We will also take inspiration from the pioneer and explorer Sir Ernest Henry Shackleton, who travelled to the Antarctic. In our class text, *Wolf Wilder*, we journey into the life of Feo, a girl fighting for what is right in a country that does not protect people's rights.

As writers: we will be writing stories, flashbacks and biographies.

As readers: we will read Katherine Rundell's 'Wolf Wilder' about a girl's adventurous journey through the snow to save her mother - a 'wolf wilder'.

In Maths: we multiply and divide fractions, calculate percentages, calculate missing angles and lengths, solve problems involving shapes, and investigate decimals and measure.

In Science: we classify plants, animals and micro-organisms.

In Computing: we will develop our coding skills, learn about managing online information and online relationships.

In Art: we will look at the work of Kenojuak Ashevak and will create monochromatic collages with use of negative space.

In History: we will learn about the sinking of the Titanic and Ernest Shackleton's journey of survival in the Antarctic.

In Languages: we will be speaking, listening and writing about likes, dislikes and sports.

In Music: we will learn to play percussion, reading notation from a stave.

In PE: we will take part in gymnastics and netball.

In PSHE: we will learn about our health and wellbeing including drugs and alcohol, first aid, and appreciation of what we have.

In RE: we will learn about Islam and their beliefs about life, death and the afterlife.
