	Spelling Pattern	Spellings Taught
WB: 01.06.2026	ey making the 'ee' sound	money, donkey, key, monkey, chimney, valley, honey, alley
WB: 08.06.2026	Adding -es to nouns and verbs ending in y (the y is changed to an i before adding -es)	flies, tries, replies, copies, babies, carries, marries, replies, hurries, fries
WB: 15.06.2026	Changing the y to i when adding the suffixes -er and - est	happier, happiest, tidier, tidiest, sillier, silliest, lazier, laziest, funnier, funniest
WB: 22.06.2026	Adding -est and -y to words ending in an e <i>Drop the e</i>	nicest, cutest, finest, safest, largest, shiny, lazy, bony, spicy, noisy
WB: 29.06.2026	Doubling the final consonant when adding the suffixes -er and -est	bigger, biggest, fatter, fattest, sadder, saddest, thinner, thinnest, wetter, wettest
WB: 06.07.2026	Suffixes -ment, -ness, - ful, -less	fearless, penniless, beautiful, plentiful, ugliness, tidiness, happiness, merriment
WB: 13.07.2026	Contractions	didn't, don't, it'll, he'll, can't, won't, hasn't, wasn't, couldn't, shouldn't
