

Birchwood Primary School uniform



We believe that children should wear a uniform at school. We want children to take pride in being part of Birchwood Primary School and to maintain a well-dressed and smart appearance. Our school uniform has been designed to ensure that they are comfortable, durable and are easily accessible from most large supermarkets.



For P.E., children should bring a change of clothes to wear and will change after dinnertime. They will go home in their P.E. kit.

Children should wear:

- A plain white T-shirt
- Plain black shorts or black jogging bottoms
- Plain sweatshirts or tracksuit tops in colder weather
- Plain black or white trainers for outside, and pumps for inside

If your child has earrings, these must be removed for P.E. sessions or covered with plasters from home. This is to prevent accidents during lessons.

Our uniform shows that our children belong to our school community. Looking smart also supports a positive school culture and promotes positive learning behaviours.

Children should wear:

- A plain white polo shirt
- Plain black trousers or black skirt
- A blue school jumper or cardigan with the school logo (these can be purchased through the school uniform shop on our website)
- Plain white/black socks or black tights
- Black school shoes
- In warmer months, children may wear black tailored shorts or a blue gingham dress
- If your child has their ears pierced, they should only wear small silver or gold studs
- Long hair is tied back with a plain blue or black hairband

Acceptable and suitable footwear guidance:

Acceptable – Plain black shoes of suitable design that are smart, safe and protect against weather. Boots may only be worn if the weather is particularly bad. Examples include -
