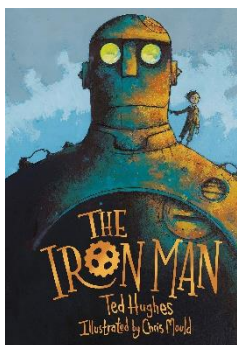




Curriculum Information

Spring | Year 3



Our topic this half term is 'Forces, Magnets and Metals'.

Hogarth and The Iron Man from our key text 'The Iron Man' are our guides through our Forces, Magnets and Metals theme. We learn all about different metals and what they are used for, explore magnetism and how this works, along with focusing our scientific investigations on forces.

As writers, we will be writing a character description, a diary entry and an advert.

As readers, we will read 'The Iron Man' by the author Ted Hughes and illustrated by Chris Mould. We will go on an adventure with Hogarth and the Iron Man to save the Earth from a terrible monster from outer space.

In Maths, we will learn to calculate problems involving measures, multiplication and division and derive multiplication and division facts.

In Science, we will find out about and investigate forces and magnets.

In Computing, we will be using Purple Mash to code, understand why copyright laws exist and discussing online relationships.

In Design and Technology, we will be preparing breakfast pots and learning where the produce comes from.

In Languages, we will be speaking, listening and writing about animals.

In Music, we will be playing a percussion instrument as a whole class and revisiting prior learning.

In PSHE, we will learn about road safety as well as using My Happy Mind to learn the importance of appreciating oneself, others and experiences.

In PE, we will take part in team games (skills for football). Oak class will be swimming and Maple class will continue their gymnastics learning.

In RE, we will learn about Muslim beliefs and pilgrimage.
