The Challenge:

For our fourth house competition, we have teamed up with a community project in Tamworth to celebrate St. George's Day! As part of these celebrations, Tamworth council are creating a community display in the town centre and want children from across the area to contribute.

We are asking you to create a 'coat of arms' which represents you as a person. It could include your local area, your favourite activities and hobbies, your school, family or even your pets!

The rules:

On the reverse side of this letter, there is a template for you to use when creating your 'coat of arms'. Your design should represent 'you' and should contain drawings of everything which makes up your life! But don't feel limited by the template – if you want to make something bigger and more creative, then let your imagination run wild!

Please also ensure that your name, class and house name are clearly indicated on your design – this will make judging much easier!

Your designs will need to be completed and brought into school before the Easter holidays or by **Tuesday 14th April at the latest**. Please hand them in to your teacher or to Mr Hammersley.

All entries to the competition will receive one house point, which will be added to the house score. The house with the most entries will also receive a 10 point bonus. Second place will receive a five-point bonus, 3rd place will receive 3 points.


