Our topic this half term is 'Take One Author - Roald Dahl'.

What a tasty topic this is! Year 3 have a golden ticket to explore the magical world of Roald Dahl through stories including Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Fantastic Mr Fox and The Twits. A visit to Cadbury World will inspire us to design our own scrumdiddlyumptious healthy treat packaging. A deliciously fun topic full of creativity and imagination!

As writers, we will be writing a recount, instructions, character descriptions and poems.

As Readers, we will enjoy listening to Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and study Fantastic Mr Fox in more detail, using our wider reading skills.

In Maths, we will learn about measures, multiplication and division, as well as explore calculation strategies and place value.

In Science, we will find out about animals, including humans, the purpose of skeletons and how skeletons differ in different animals.

In Art, we will be exploring the illustrations of Quentin Blake.

In Computing, we will be using spread sheets and how to manage our online information.

In Design and Technology, we will design packaging and create shell structures using computer aided design.

In Geography, we will be learning about food distribution and Fair-Trade food.

In Languages, we will be speaking, listening and writing about the area we live in.

In Music, we will play an ostinato on untuned percussion as part of an accompaniment to a song and play crochet and quaver patterns using notes A and C.
