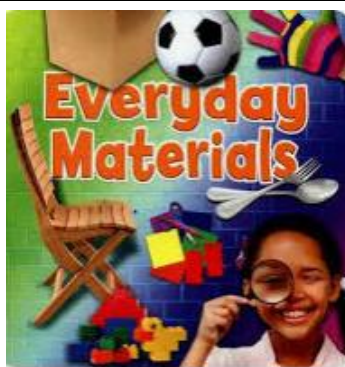




Our topic this half term is 'Everyday Materials'.

Our journey starts when we meet three little pigs who set off to build themselves new homes but someone big and bad soon comes looking for a tasty snack. The pigs manage to outwit the wolf and he disappears. How will they find him and will they ever become friends?

As writers, we will be exploring adjectives and nouns that can be used to create a reimagined.

As readers, we will share a number of books -The Three Little Pigs and The Story Machine. We will also be exposed to a range of books during our guided reading sessions.

In Maths, we will explore numbers within 10. This will include representing numbers, finding 1 more and 1 less, doubling and halving and exploring addition and subtraction. We will also be identifying and classifying 2D and 3D shapes, investigating repeated patterns and using and following instructional and positional language.

In Science, we will find out about materials and their properties.

In Art, we will be looking at some of the work created by Van Gogh and be creating our own 'Starry Night' masterpieces using some of the techniques taught.

In Design and Technology, we will be finding out where flour comes from before making pitta bread pockets.

In Computing, we will be exploring Purple Mash to find resources and adding pictures and text to a document.

In Geography, we will be exploring the location of the equator and the North and South Poles and investigating the temperature of countries located near to the equator.

In Music, we learn a song about menus, play classroom instruments and begin to compose.

In PSHE, we will learn about protective behaviours and our school rules and looking after our world.

In PE, we will take part in dance and team games.

In RE, we will learn about Christianity and the creation story.
