BASE and After School Activities

Birchwood Additional School Experience (BASE) is an important element of our positive approach towards behaviour in school. At the end of every week children who have demonstrated excellent learning behaviour in school and who have followed our one school rule of 'Consideration and Respect' earn their BASE Skills time on a Friday afternoon. This is a really positive way to end the school week and children really look forward to spending this time with their friends and teachers, learning and developing new skills.

To support our aim to provide all our children with 'Rich Opportunities and Memorable Experiences' we have organised to run a total of 33 after school activities during the summer term. Over the last 12 months all of our children have missed out on taking part in activities outside of the school day. Children have not been able to go to football training, dance and gymnastic classes, swimming lessons and have missed out on a whole host of other activities and interests they have.

At Birchwood we are determined to try and make up for lost time and I am really pleased that we are able to offer so many after school clubs during the summer term. These have been organised across school and will be run in year groups to ensure that children do not mix with children from another year group. Over the course of the next two half terms we will have our sports coaches from Top Score, Aston Villa and Embody dance delivering football, multi sports and dance. Our brilliant staff at Birchwood are also supporting our after school provision. Some of the additional after school activities on offer include art, dodgeball, cooking, rounders, playground games, drama, ukulele, gardening, cricket, running, tennis and 'Now Press Play'.

I want to say thank you to all our staff for giving up their time to support our school offer to children. They all work extremely hard and are very busy people. I am really proud that at Birchwood we continue to put the needs of our children first.

This has been a very challenging term for everyone involved, but as a school community, together we have made the best out of a difficult situation. Our parents have all done a fantastic job supporting children with their learning when at home. Our teaching staff have gone above and beyond in continuing to support our children's progress through the curriculum, whether in school or at home. And throughout this term our children have shown resilience, determination and a positive can do

We all look forward to a more positive summer term and cannot wait to get started with our after school activities. But for now, we are all in need of a very well deserved Easter holiday.

Spotlight this week is ... on Identifying close contacts



In the event of a positive case of COVID 19 being identified within school, we always make contact with Public Health England and are led by their advice on identification of those children and adults who have been 'close contacts' of the positive case.

In this identification process, there are a number of factors which are taken into consideration including the timing of the test and the time that the person testing positive has been in school. The age of the children is also taken into account, as are our classroom seating plans and the activities that the children have undertaken during the time we are advised to identify contacts from.

Every case is considered on an individual basis. The process is applied to both children and staff to ensure all close contacts are given the appropriate advice regarding isolation. Children and staff not deemed to be close contacts can remain in school.


Although it been a quieter year for TBPS we are still busy trying to find ways to support the school. As always, we are looking for any new volunteers and we are also looking for a secretary. If you
