# <u>Team Birchwood – Parent Teacher and Friends</u> Association of Birchwood Primary School

Team Birchwood (TBPS) are a committed and dedicated group of parents, carers, teachers and friends who support the school through a variety of different events that they run throughout the year. Their main objective is to run fantastic events that not only raise much needed funds to support improvement projects that have a direct impact on our children, but also at the same time provide our children with 'Rich Opportunities and Memorable Experiences'.

Last year Team Birchwood set themselves a very ambitious target of raising over £5000 in one year so that they could be registered as an official charity. I am very pleased to say that through a lot of hard work, time and determination, they managed to achieve this fantastic total. The benefits of being an official registered charity are that TBPS can now apply for grants and seek support from companies and organisiations that are only able to support registered charities.

The money TBPS raise is spent directly on our children. Members of Team Birchwood attend School Council and Eco-Council meetings to talk directly with children about what they would like the money to be spent on. Recently TBPS have paid for a piece of Trim Trail equipment in our Lower School Playground and they are hoping to be able to sponsor a piece of Trim Trail equipment in our Upper School playground in the summer too. They also have plans to buy equipment, seating and canopy shelters to support the Eco-Council with the development of our wooded area.

This year Team Birchwood are hard at it again in their pursuit to raise even more funds to spend on our children. This week alone has seen TBPS invite parents and children from Reception to a Tea Party to welcome them to our school. On Thursday they also successfully ran two Movie nights, one for the Lower school and one for the Upper school. The children thoroughly enjoyed being able to watch a movie in school with their friends and tuck into a bit of cinema style food.

The next big event for TBPS is our hugely popular Christmas Fair. Preparations for this large event start in September at their Annual General Meeting and build over time right up until the day of the Fair. I am sure this year will be even better than before (if that is possible).

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our wonderful volunteers from Team Birchwood for all the work, time and effort that they put into running the events they hold in school. I would also like to thank all our brilliant school staff, who help support at the events themselves, as well as giving a big thankyou to all the parents and pupils who attend. Our school really would not work without the team efforts of all!

# Spotlight on Traffic around our school

At Birchwood we are keen to ensure we do all we can to help children learn how to stay safe on the roads, and this week saw us elect our new 'Road Safety Officers' in our Key Stage 2 classes. Their job is to help pass on safety messages to children about how to stay safe near to and when crossing roads.

We are also aware that our school is situated on a road which is very busy, especially at the start and end of the school day. Crossing and parking has become a real concern over recent months. We have been working very closely with local authorities to improve this situation and there will be work starting imminently to ensure that people park more considerately and safely outside of our school. Fencing will be erected and markings painted to clearly show the areas that must be left clear. In the longer term the road safety team from the local authority are hoping to install a puffin crossing which will improve things even further.

Please make sure you share the message with your children that being safe around the roads is important and show them how to cross the road safely at all times.

## **PANTS - The Underwear Rule**

In school we teach children about how to keep safe and when they should tell adults about things that happen to them that seem wrong. The NSPCC have developed some



really good rules to help children understand where and when it is wrong to be touched by another person. They call it the 'Underwear Rule' and use the word PANTS to help children understand the elements. We aim to introduce this to children shortly.

# How and when to start conversations with your child about keeping themselves safe.

The NSPCC suggest that small, open and honest conversations are the best way to introduce the 'Underwear Rule' to keep your child safe and talk about keeping safe. Inevitably your child will have questions, so listen carefully and attentively and be straightforward in your answers. You know your child best of all, so adapt the conversation and talk in a way that feels right for you both. # Privates are private

Be clear with your child that the parts of their body covered by underwear are private. Explain to your child that no one should ask to see or touch their private parts or ask them to look at or touch anyone else's. Sometimes doctors, nurses or family members might have to. Explain that this is OK, but that those people should always explain why, and ask your child if it's OK first


