<u>Celebrating Positive Behaviour -</u> <u>BASE Skills Academy</u>

At Birchwood we view primary education as far more than just Maths and English. We firmly believe in providing all our pupils with 'rich opportunities and memorable experiences'. We have a very creative thematic curriculum that supports the development of skills in all foundation subjects, offering pupils a broad and balanced curriculum experience. We strive to improve children's development in the foundation subjects and in recent years have been awarded with 'Science Gold Quality Mark', 'Arts Mark Gold', '360 online safety mark', 'Food For Life Silver award' and 'Young Carers Silver award', as recognition for our efforts.

At Birchwood we are very keen to celebrate children who are brilliantly behaved and considerate all of the time. To reward them for being at their Birchwood Best, the children get to choose and take part in 'Skills Academy' to support our BASE (Birchwood Additional School Experience) programme. If pupils have followed our one school rule of Consideration all week and have tried their very best in all their learning, they will be entitled to thirty minutes of BASE skills academy time. During BASE Skills time, pupils will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of enjoyable skills based activities of their choice, run by our fabulous teachers and teaching assistants. Skills academy runs between 2:30 and 3:00pm in phases - Year 1-2, Year 3-4 and Year 5-6. Pupils will get to choose from a range of different skills activities in each phase including lego, football, music, art, dance, cooking and many more. They will spend the half term practicing and refining these skills during their BASE time. Each half term there will be a new set of skills activities for the children to choose.

There are many advantages to our Skills Academy. Children have the opportunity to learn and develop new skills in a wide range of enjoyable activities. They will get to learn with children from other classes, work in smaller groups and develop positive relationships with different teachers and teaching assistants. It also gives us all something fun and exciting to look forward to at the end of the school week.

At Birchwood we are proud that our pupil's enjoy coming to school and that they look forward to their skills time after doing their Birchwood Best all week. We believe that every child in our school is good at something and it is our aim to find, nurture and celebrate those talents. We know that our 'BASE Skills Academy' helps support us to achieve this.

SCHOOL - KEEP - CLEAR.


NO IFS ... NO BUTS ... NO EXCUSE KEEP THE ZIG-ZAGS CLEAR !!!

School Crossing Patrol Vacancy



A vacancy has arisen for a School Crossing Patrol Operative outside of Birchwood School. Times are to be confirmed, but the position will require morning and afternoon cover, at the busiest times of the school day. Usually shifts

are around 30 minutes each. The position is for Monday to Friday term time only (38 weeks per year spread across 12 monthly payments.) Pay for this position is £8.61 per hour plus holiday enhancements. A uniform and full training will be provided.

Myths and Legends.

'It doesn't matter if my child is late for school'

Not what the children would say! They absolutely hate being late. They arrive after all their friends are already sat down in school and enter a classroom of 30 others looking at them. At the start of the day teachers take registers, explain to the children what they will be doing for the day and all sorts of other important instructions about what will be happening around school. Persistent lateness will often result in contact from Education Social Workers who inspect our registers and will prosecute for persistent cases.

Parent Information Sessions/ Coffee Chats

Warwickshire Primary Mental Health Team offer FREE Parent Information Sessions and Coffee Chats within the local community! At these sessions you will have the opportunity to meet other parents and learn about common emotional wellbeing concerns in children/young people and find out what you can do to help! Parent Information Sessions are more structured sessions on a particular topic and afterwards. Coffee Chats are more informal, where you can get to know other parents and have a 'chat' about your experiences!

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Understanding and supporting children aged 3-11 years with Anxiety - 7th Oct 2019

You will learn about anxiety and how can we help our children people manage their worries. You will learn to identify the signs & symptoms of anxiety and how it might present in children of different ages. You will learn to differentiate between the usual stresses of childhood, and anxiety that may be more problematic for your child. You will learn practical strategies and techniques you can do at home to support your child when they are feeling anxious. You will also find out where you can access local support if you are worried about your child's emotional wellbeing.

Children's Choice Menu

Over the last few years, Birchwood have worked very closely with Educaterers to create an exciting school meal menu.

On Thursday 3rd October 2019, Birchwood are having a Children's Choice Menu in school, which will be a choice of hot dog or pizza served with sweetcorn or baked beans and cross cut fries or a jacket potato with a choice of fillings. Dessert will be a choice of cracknel or ice cream.

As one of our census days, the money allocated to school for school meals is partly based on the number of children who take a meal on that day. We are therefore very keen to get as many children taking a school meal as possible particularly Reception, Yr 1 and Yr 2 children who are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals. For children in years 3-6 the cost of this one meal will be £2.25 which can be paid for on ParentPay.

Normally if children choose school meals they are required to do so for the whole week, but as a one off they can just take the school meal on that day if they wish to. We hope as many children as possible take the opportunity to try this delicious school meal.
