#### **Good Manners in School**

At Birchwood, we are extremely proud of the continual high standards our children set themselves and each other. We believe that it is very important that children show each other consideration and respect. The excellent manners our children demonstrate on a daily basis provide the platform for our warm, welcoming and inclusive school environment.

In school, our children all know what is expected of them. We discuss our one school rule and the positive ethos we want to achieve. We think that it is important to make our expectations clear and to model these ourselves so that our children can see good manners in action.

There are lots of ways that we can show good manners, but the 10 most important to us at Birchwood are:

- 1. Say 'please' this shows consideration to others.
- Say 'thank you' this demonstrates appreciation and gratitude.
- 3. In return, say 'you are welcome' this demonstrates that you are happy to help.
- 4. Apologise this shows empathy and that you take responsibility for your actions.
- 5. Smile this makes everything better for yourself and others.
- 6. Holding the door open for others this demonstrates a kind gesture of support.
- Ask questions of others this shows interest in other's ideas and feelings.
- Say, 'excuse me please' this shows consideration for others.
- Compliment each other this makes others feel good and helps build relationships.
- Share this shows we care, helps us think of others and shows you appreciate what you have.

Reinforcing good manners isn't hard. We do this on a daily basis and is something that we have all come to expect off each other. Sometimes we reinforce these messages deliberately in assemblies or class discussions, but generally these are positively modelled by staff, parents and children themselves.

Starting each day with a friendly greeting and ending the day with a friendly goodbye, supports a positive day in-between. We are very appreciative of the role our families and parents play in supporting the manners our children display and the important role these have in the success of our school.

Just like smiles, manners are free! They both make a huge difference to how we feel about ourselves and each other!


